 Designed by Ron Arad, the chrome-plated PizzaKobra spiral light resembles a pizza when collapsed and a cobra when expanded. A standby sensor turns on six white LEDs with a single touch, and light is captured and reflected between the hinges.

**2 Recreate**

 Each Suitcase Chair is individually made with complementary upholstery fabric and handcrafted legs, and reinforced with a steel-and-timber structure.

**3 Fatboy the Original**

 Inspired by the late baroque style of the 18th century, the RockCoco outdoor chandelier by Dutch designer DeMakersVan features red wiring and a transparent exterior. Try hanging it from a tree for outdoor dining or above a swimming pool.

 The Aurora chimney-free fireplace draws inspiration from the aurora borealis, the natural and colorful light display in the sky, and features a natural stone surface and five translucent colored legs.
